Writing Your Clues for the Class 2 Treasure Hunt

FIRST: If you haven't already, watch the short video.

Great! Now you are ready to look at how to go about doing your part in our SURPRISE treasure hunt for class 2.

I will ask Bronwyn to put Class 2 into four groups. The children in each of these groups will work together to get to the treasure by following the course that their class 7 group has set.

Each class 7 group will be assigned coloured paper to write their clues on when we get back to school. (This will distinguish each group's clues.) Your task now is to write your clue in your draft book and keep it safe until we are back at school.

You need to find your name below and then look along that row to the column that says, "where you need to get them to go" and come up with a riddle or a cryptic clue that directs the children to this landmark. For example, Hayden's clue will be planted at the class 2 sandpit and his clue needs to direct the class 2s to the sailing boat. He might write a poem about being out on the high seas, but not mention sailing or boats. Or he might think of a riddle where the answer is 'sailing boat', something like that...
