Morning Verse –

Each morning, say the verse. If you are allowed to, light a candle first.

Tips: There is a copy of the verse below. if you need to, print it out and keep it somewhere handy.

Recorder Practice – 10 minutes each morning

- 1) Run through the two songs you have been given so far.
- 2) Look at the faster notes in Cantate Domino and use small sections of these as scales to warm up your fingers and get used to the patterns of the notes.
- 3) Practice Cantate Domino remember to practise a bar or two until it feels smooth and then build on this by practising the next couple of bars and joining it all together.
- 4) There is an audio available to listen to and try to play along with.

Maths Practice – 20 mins each morning

A one or two-page worksheet will be put up on the website each day with answers given on the following day. Each morning you can go over yesterday's work with the provided answers, then go on with the day's worksheet.

You can email me a copy of your work if you like, so I know how you are going. It's very helpful for me to see.

Tips: If it feels more manageable, set yourself the task of doing half of the sums for each question and then go back and do the rest if you are able.

Working with words – 10 mins each morning

This week we are going to learn a poem as much by heart as possible. You can put a copy somewhere you will see it often and practise it for 10 minutes each morning as well.
