Today's Bookwork

Yesterday you wrote a draft piece of writing about an experience of wonder you had when you were younger.

Firstly, look over your writing and see how you can make it more descriptive. Can you add to any actions or objects in your writing by adding adverbs or adjectives? Perhaps something like 'small' can become 'tinier than my little fingernail'... see how you go developing this part of your writing.

Secondly, can you look at your writing and judge if it sounds a bit like a list of events... have you said, "and then this happened..."? Take a bit of time now to see if you can make your writing more like a poem. It doesn't have to rhyme, but can you tell your wonder experience in a way that is more than writing about a sequence of events. Make sure you write about how the experience felt, what was around you, how you reacted and so on. This takes some concentration and a willingness to spend some time pondering.

Once you are happy with your draft, write it up in your Main Lesson book, under the heading:

"An Experience of Wonder as my Younger Self"

Decorate this page in a way that fits with what you wrote about.
